Arts and Culture Capital Support Decision-Making Framework

The Arts and Culture program uses the following criteria to assess a project's alignment with this strategy.

Artistic or Cultural Practice

ABSENT

No impact or influence on artistic field.

EMERGENT

Limited impact on or influence on artistic field.

DEVELOPING

Considerable influence on the artistic field and region.

STRONG

Work is essential to the artistic field, community, or region.

"STRONG" REQUIRED

Organizational Strength

ABSENT

Vage or unformed plan for future operations.

EMERGENT

Stable financial health with limited plan to develop resources for expanded program/ activity.

DEVELOPING

Stable financial health with moderately clear approach to business model, gaps in budget and resources.

STRONG

Strong financial health, equipped with business model, necessary assets, and resources to sustain expanded program/activity.

"STRONG" REQUIRED

Achievability

ABSENT

Unrealistic project plan, budget and/or resources for expected results.

EMERGENT

Limited plan, misaligned, or unclear alignment with budget and resources.

DEVELOPING

Moderately clear project plan, gaps in fund development and resources.

STRONG

A detailed project plan including a clear project budget, financing, construction documents, and an implementation schedule.

"STRONG" REQUIRED

Orientation to Racial Equity, Economic Inclusion, and Accessibility for People with Disabilities

ABSENT

Vague or non-existent goals.

EMERGENT

Limited goals focused on inclusion and access.

DEVELOPING

Clearly articulated approach to make artistic and cultural work inclusive and accessible.

STRONG

Project is designed with a goal to address structural inequities of access and opportunity.

"DEVELOPING" OR "STRONG" REQUIRED

Community/People-Centered Practice

ABSENT

Minimal evidence of community input.

EMERGENT

Project consulted with community for some activities.

DEVELOPING

Project is building on community relationships and collaborative practices.

STRONG

Project is informed by long-standing history of inclusive and community-informed practices.

DEVELOPING" OR "STRONG" REQUIRED

Promotes Stewardship of Existing Cultural Assets

ABSENT

Not an existing cultural asset

EMERGENT

Is an existing cultural asset but project does not represent an investment in the existing asset; but the project will benefit the institution overall.

DEVELOPING

Represents a partial or modest investment in an existing cultural asset and the project will benefit the institution overall.

STRONG

Represents an important enhancement of or reinvestment in an existing cultural institution.

"DEVELOPING" OR "STRONG" REQUIRED

Leverages a Prior Foundation Investment

ABSENT

No prior WPF investment.

EMERGENT

Historic but no recent WPF investment.

DEVELOPING

Recent* but modest WPF investment.

STRONG

Recent* major WPF investment.

"DEVELOPING" OR "STRONG" REQUIRED
